

CONFIDENTIALITY AGREEMENT - 2010/2011

During the entrepreneurship competition, Venture Cup Danmark 2010/2011 ("the Competition"), in which I will participate as an advisor, staff, volunteer, member of the jury or in the competition management, I commit - toward the competition organization as well as the participants - to the following:

1. Commitments for advisors, members of the jury and the competition management

1.1 I hereby commit not to reveal to third party, directly or indirectly, confidential information and confidential working-material, according to the definition below ("information") which is shared with me within the context of the Competition, or in other matters related to the Competition during the validity of this confidentiality agreement.

1.2 I commit to use any information only for preparation and execution of the Competition and only to pass information onto third parties with explicit permission from the competition participant, unless the involvement of a third party is needed for the execution of the Competition. A third party is anyone other than the participant revealing the confidential information.

1.3 I commit, where applicable, to secure that the obligations of confidentiality mentioned above are also met by third parties involved by me.

1.4 I commit to destroy all information that I have received within the context of the Competition, in any form this information may exist, no later than June 30, 2011.

2. Confidential information and confidential working-material

2.1 By information is understood all technical, financial or other information that a competition participant reveals, regardless of how it happens.

2.2 Any information which is publicly known, or information which gets publicly known, without anybody violating the rules above, is not confidential information. Subsequently, information which at the time of delivery was already known to me, is not considered confidential information.

3. Validity

This confidentiality agreement refers to information that I will receive during the period of the competition from July, 2010 through June 2011. The obligation to maintain secrecy of such information according to this agreement applies to a period of 2 years from the end of the Competition in June 2011.

ETHICAL RULES

I respect and will not take advantage of the uneven relationship between participants and the project administration, hence, the project management must always act in the best interest of the participants.

If a member of the project management wishes to enter into financial relationship with a participant, the board has to be informed. The project management and board are bound to secrecy in these matters.
